




Finished Pinwheel Block size (all dimensions are in inches)	Patch A - Cut eight half-square triangles from four pinwheel fabric squares of this size (see note1):	Patch B - Cut four quarter-square triangles from one background square of this size square (see note2):	Patch C - Cut four background fabric rectangles this width and length. After sewing Patch C to Blade Patch A, trim to fit.
