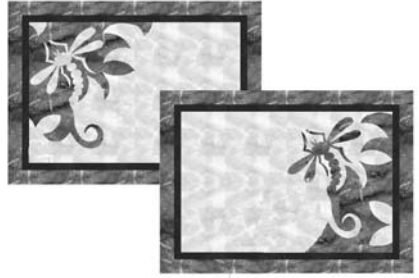


# Dragonflies Bonus Pattern

One freezer paper pattern can make  
up to eight great looking  
13½" by 18½" placemats

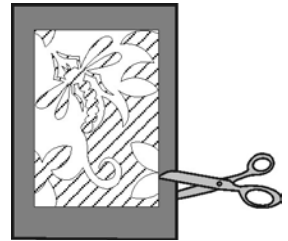
Fabric Requirements for 2 placemats

- Background Two 12" x 17"
- Medium Print One 9" x 12"
- Inner Border 1/8 yd
- Outer Border 1/8 yd
- Backing One Fat Quarter
- Binding 1/4 yd
- Batting Two pieces 15" x 20"
- Steam-a-Seam® Fusible web One piece 8" x 11"



Follow the instructions for making small wall quilt in  
"Dragonflies" pattern with the following changes:

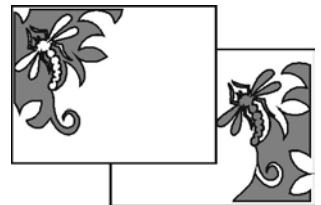
- Step 2 - DO NOT cut freezer paper pattern on dashed line. Instead cut the freezer paper into quarters. Use one section for 2 placemats.
- Steps 3 & 4 - Prepare and cut dragonflies from ONE piece of 9" x 12" print.



- Step 6 thru 8 - After Step 5 you will have two sections of medium print dragonflies. Trim right section to create pleasing shape on bottom left. Position one section on each of two background pieces.



- Step 9 - Skip this step.
- Step 10 - Square up each section to 10½" x 15½".
- Step 11 - Cut 1" inner border strips.
- Step 12 - Cut 1½" outer border strips.
- Steps 13 thru 20 - Continue according to pattern directions.
